TAJUK UTAMA: INDEKS HARGA PENGGUNA (IHP) MENURUN SEBANYAK 0.05 PERATUS TAHUN-KE-TAHUN PADA BULAN MAC 2019

1. Indeks Harga Pengguna (IHP) bagi bulan Mac 2019 menurun sebanyak 0.05 peratus tahun-ke-tahun berbanding dengan bulan Mac 2018. Harga Makanan dan Minuman Ringan mencatatkan penurunan sebanyak 0.5 peratus. Manakala, harga Bukan Makanan mencatatkan peningkatan sebanyak 0.1 peratus.
2. Penurunan IHP sebahagian besarnya adalah disebabkan oleh penurunan harga dan kos Perumahan, Air, Elektrik, Gas dan Bahan Api Lain (3.3 peratus); Makanan dan Minuman Ringan (0.5 peratus); dan Perhiasan, Peralatan Isi Rumah dan Penyelenggaraan Rutin Isi Rumah (0.3 peratus). Walau bagaimanapun, ianya diimbangi oleh peningkatan harga dan kos Kesihatan (3.1 peratus); Rekreasi dan Kebudayaan (2.6 peratus); dan Pengangkutan (0.6 peratus).
3. Harga Perumahan, Air, Elektrik, Gas dan Bahan Api Lain menurun berikutan penurunan harga sewa rumah dan bahan untuk penyelenggaraan dan pembaikan kediaman. Manakala, penurunan harga Makanan dan Minuman Ringan mengambil kira harga rendah sayur-sayuran, ayam dan telur. Penurunan dalam Perhiasan, Peralatan Isi Rumah dan Penyelenggaraan Rutin Isi Rumah pula adalah disebabkan oleh harga perabot ruang tamu/ruang makan dan perabot bilik tidur yang menurun.
4. Bagi perubahan bulan-ke-bulan, IHP bagi Mac 2019 meningkat sebanyak 0.5 peratus berbanding dengan bulan Februari 2019. Indeks Makanan dan Minuman Ringan meningkat sebanyak 0.1 peratus, manakala Indeks Bukan Makanan meningkat sebanyak 0.6 peratus.
5. IHP mengukur perubahan harga barang dan perkhidmatan yang dibayar oleh pengguna dalam satu tempoh masa yang ditetapkan dan dikumpulkan setiap bulan. Senarai barang dan perkhidmatan dalam IHP adalah berdasarkan maklumat perbelanjaan purata sebuah keluarga yang diperolehi melalui Kajian Perbelanjaan Keluarga. **HEADLINE: CONSUMER PRICE INDEX (CPI) FELL BY 0.05 PER CENT
YEAR-ON-YEAR IN MARCH 2019**

1. *The Consumer Price Index (CPI) in March 2019 decreased by 0.05 per cent year-on-year compared to March 2018. Prices of Food and Non-Alcoholic Beverages decreased by 0.5 per cent. Meanwhile, Non-Food prices increased by 0.1 per cent.*
2. *The CPI decrease was largely attributed to decreases in the prices and costs of Housing, Water, Electricity, Gas and Other Fuels (3.3 per cent); Food and Non-Alcoholic Beverages (0.5 per cent); and Furnishings, Household Equipment and Routine Household Maintenance (0.3 per cent). However, this was moderated by increases in prices and costs of Health (3.1 per cent); Recreation and Culture (2.6 per cent); and Transport (0.6 per cent).*
3. *Prices of Housing, Water, Electricity, Gas and Other Fuels decreased following the decrease in prices of rental and materials for the maintenance and repair of dwellings. Meanwhile, the decrease in the prices of Food and Non-Alcoholic Beverages was due to low prices of vegetables, chicken and eggs. The decline in Furnishings, Household Equipment and Routine Household Maintenance was attributed to the reduced prices of living/dining room furniture and bedroom furniture.*
4. *On a month-on-month basis, the CPI in March 2019 increased by 0.5 per cent compared to February 2019. The Food and Non-Alcoholic Beverages Index increased by 0.1 per cent, while the Non-Food Index increased by 0.6 per cent.*
5. *The CPI is a measure of price changes of goods and services paid by the consumer in a specified period and compiled on a monthly basis. The list of goods and services in the CPI is based on the average expenditure per household from the Household Expenditure Survey (HES).
