**THE OPENING CEREMONY OF
MOFE LEADERSHIP EXECUTIVE PROGRAM (MOFE-LEP) AND
EXECUTIVE SYMPOSIUM ON LEADERSHIP AND PUBLIC SERVICE TRANSFORMATION
IN COLLABORATION WITH
TEMASEK FOUNDATION (TF) AND CIVIL SERVICE COLLEGE (CSC), SINGAPORE**

Thursday, 11 August 2022

1. The Ministry of Finance and Economy (MOFE) Leadership Executive Program (MOFE-LEP) is a joint collaboration program between the Human Resource Development and Corporate Affairs Division, Ministry of Finance and Economy, Brunei Darussalam and Temasek Foundation (TF) and supported by Civil Service College (CSC), Singapore. This program was launched on 11 August 2022 at the Theatre Hall, Ministry of Finance and Economy Building, Brunei Darussalam.
2. Present as the Guest-of-Honour (GOH) at the program launch was Yang Berhormat Dato Seri Setia Dr Awang Haji Mohd Amin Liew bin Abdullah, Minister at the Prime Minister's Office and Minister of Finance and Economy II.
3. The launch event commenced with the recitation of the Surah Al-Fatihah and Doa Selamat. This is followed by the Welcoming Remarks by Mr Roger Tan, Assistant Chief Executive (International), Civil Service College, Singapore and a Keynote Speech from the event's GOH, Yang Berhormat Dato Seri Setia Dr Awang Haji Mohd Amin Liew bin Abdullah, Minister at the Prime Minister's Office and Minister of Finance and Economy II.
4. The MOFE-LEP aims to build capabilities of high potential leaders in the Ministry of Finance and Economy, Brunei (MOFE) and their partners in the areas of strategic planning and implementation. This programme also aims to support MOFE officers and partners in developing a set of project planning tools and templates for future project implementation. The programme will share Singapore's whole-of-government and multi-sectoral approach to public sector transformation particularly in strategic planning and implementation with a focus on the public finance and economic sector.
5. The MOFE-LEP consists of several workshop sessions and a study visit to Singapore. The speakers and facilitators involved representatives from the CSC and TF, Singapore. A total of thirty (30) program participants including senior officers from the Ministry of Finance and Economy as well as from various ministries participated in the said programme.
6. The afternoon session witnessed an Executive Symposium on Leadership and Public Service Transformation which was presented by Mr Yee Ping Yi, Deputy Secretary (Planning), Ministry of Finance, Singapore. The executive symposium served as a platform for Brunei and Singapore to share and exchange experiences.
