



## **INTRODUCTION OF A NEW FEATURE TO ONE COMMON PORTAL (OCP) – e-STAMPING MODULE**

1. The Ministry of Finance and Economy (MOFE) is pleased to announce that in support of the Government's digital transformation initiative, Revenue Division, MOFE will introduce the e-Stamping module service which is expected to be launched in the Fourth Quarter of 2022.
2. e-Stamping module will enable the public to perform, manage and pay Stamp Duty online for certain instruments without having to physically attend at the Stamp Duty Collector agencies counters including the Land Department, Ministry of Development and the National Department of Justice in the Prime Minister's Office. Such module will introduce new Stamp Duty assessment and payment procedures as follows:
  - i. Enable the use of online Stamp Duty forms;
  - ii. Upload the instrument to be stamped;
  - iii. Automatic Stamp Duty calculation;
  - iv. Online Stamp Duty Payment; and
  - v. Issuance of Stamp Duty Certificate.
3. In this regard, the public is advised to register an account at One Common Portal (OCP) at [www.ocp.mofe.gov.bn](http://www.ocp.mofe.gov.bn) to be able to access this e-Stamping module as soon as it is launched.
