TAKLIMAT AKTA PENYIMPANAN REKOD (PERNIAGAAN), PENGGAL 249

1. Kementerian Kewangan dan Ekonomi (MOFE) dengan kerjasama *Brunei Darussalam Institute of Certified Public Accountants* (BICPA) telah mengadakan Sesi Taklimat Akta Penyimpanan Rekod (Perniagaan), Penggal 249 pada hari Sabtu, 9hb November 2024 yang berlangsung di Dewan Teater, Kementerian Kewangan dan Ekonomi.
2. Taklimat ini adalah bertujuan untuk memastikan peniaga-peniaga memahami dan mematuhi peruntukan undang-undang yang terkandung di dalam Akta Penyimpanan Rekod (Perniagaan), Penggal 249.

Taklimat telah disampaikan oleh YM Dayang Siti Nur Quthairah binti Shah Johan, Pegawai Kewangan di Bahagian Hasil, MOFE yang antaranya telah menjelaskan berhubung keperluan bagi setiap entiti perniagaan di Negara Brunei Darussalam untuk menyimpan rekod-rekod perniagaan dengan teratur sekurang-kurangnya untuk tempoh lima tahun selaras dengan Akta Penyimpanan Rekod (Perniagaan), Penggal 249.

Turut menyampaikan taklimat adalah YM Dayang Adeline Lau Pik Wen, Setiausaha BICPA dan Pengarah Akademi BICPA, yang telah menekankan tentang keperluan penyimpanan buku dan faedah penyediaan Penyata Kewangan yang akan membantu pemilik perniagaan dalam membuat perancangan kewangan yang teratur, membuat keputusan kewangan bagi perniagaan dan menarik pelabur-pelabur berpotensi.

BRIEFING ON RECORD KEEPING (BUSINESS) ACT, CHAPTER 249

1. The Ministry of Finance and Economy (MOFE) in collaboration with the Brunei Darussalam Institute of Certified Public Accountants (BICPA) held a Briefing Session on Record Keeping (Business) Act, Chapter 249 on Saturday, 9th November 2024 which took place at the Theatre Hall, Ministry of Finance and Economy.
2. The intention of the briefing was to ensure entrepreneurs understanding and complying with the legal provisions under the Record Keeping (Business) Act, Chapter 249.
3. The briefing was delivered by YM Dayang Siti Nur Quthairah binti Shah Johan, Finance Officer at the Revenue Division, MOFE among which she explained that it is a requirement for every business entity in Brunei Darussalam to keep business records in an orderly manner for at least a period of five years in accordance with the Record Keeping (Business) Act, Chapter 249.

Also delivering the briefing was YM Dayang Adeline Lau Pik Wen, Secretary of BICPA and Director of BICPA Academy, who emphasized on the need of bookkeeping and the benefits of preparing Financial Statements that will help business owners to make an organised financial plan, make financial decisions for the business and attract potential investors.

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
