First held in 2021, Brunei MYCE is an annual series of conferences and exhibitions planned for one month that brings together experts and key players in selected fields. 2022 Brunei MYCE will have 5 weekly themes, namely Islamic (1 – 4 June), Digital Technology (8 – 11 June), Energy (15 – 18 June), Climate Change (22 – 25 June) and Economy (28 June – 2 July). 2022 Brunei MYCE marks the first time an Economy Week will be organised.

The objective of Brunei MYCE is to promote knowledge sharing, brainstorming, sharing of new discoveries in various fields and increasing networking and business activities among experts and entrepreneurs from within and outside the country.
